FREE TIPS AND INFORMATION

1. Your dog(s) should eat after you (if you feed leftovers put them into your dog's bowl — never feed your dog(s) from the table). This is not due to dominance more for behavior modification and a well mannered companion during meals.
2. While you eat, your dog(s) must lay down, be out of the room or be outside during the meal.
3. Feed your dog on a schedule – Twice a day is most common – Leave the food down for ***only*** 20 to 30 minutes.
4. Walk thru doors before your dogs (including guests). Again, this is for manners not for a true leadership role.
5. Be sure to win ***all*** games:
 - a. Tug-of-war (if your dog is stronger then you don't play)
 - b. Staring (this is a dominance game)
 - c. Fetch (stop when you want not when your dog chooses)
6. Dog(s) should not be on furniture unless invited – this also means, they can not get off the furniture until told to.
7. Rotate your dog's toys. (Makes them think they are always new.)
8. If you are having a rough day ***don't*** do any training with your dog(s). It will only make your day worse and confuse them.
9. Work on touching ***all*** areas of your dog(s) – INCLUDING:
 - a. Opening mouth and looking at teeth.
 - b. Under tail.
 - c. Between toes.
 - d. Inside ears.
10. For ***BEST RESULTS*** train and play with your dog(s) approximately 15 to 30 minutes a day.

11. Your dog's tags should ***NOT*** say your dogs name ***or*** your name – it should say "has cancer, needs meds" or something similar. Be sure to put your phone number ***AND*** a close friend or family members number just in case you are not home or available.
12. Some of the "**quality**" pet foods recommended, ask us where to get them:
 - A: Solid Gold
 - B: Wellness
 - C: Canidae
 - D: California Natural
 - E: Wysong (purchase online at abcpetservices.com)
13. Supplements are a very good preventative for dogs over the age of 1 year. Vitamin C, Essential Fatty Oils, Glucosamine, MSM and Vitamin Tabs are all available at pet stores and local retailers.
